


MNsure Contact Center Call Volume Nov. 5 – 18, 2014






MNsure Contact Center Average Speed of Answer Nov. 5 – 18, 2014






MNsure Contact Center Percent of Calls Answered in Five Minutes or Less Nov. 5-18, 2014

- Public program enrollment is year-round
 - MinnesotaCare
 - Medical Assistance
 - Current public program enrollees should sit tight –

Coverage Deadlines

For a plan selected:	The effective date of coverage is:
On November 15, 2014 through December 15, 2014	January 1, 2015
On December 16, 2014 through January 15, 2015	February 1, 2015
On January 16, 2015 through February 15, 2015	March 1, 2015

Open enrollment: November 15, 2014 – February 15, 2015





At the Beginning

- MNsure has federal planning grant and DHS cost sharing to build and manage an eligibility and enrollment system for public programs, QHP/APTC, and SHOP.
- MNsure responsible for customer service and outreach. DHS with counties responsible for case management of public programs.
- MNsure must partner with DHS and MN.IT to accomplish – but MNsure is lead partner.
- IT build must support future scaling to run eligibility determination for rest of DHS – e.g. TANF, SNAP, Child Care



Who We Serve

- Public Program Enrollment prior to MA expansion to 75% FPL (3/2011)— 570,000
- Public Program Enrollment prior to MA expansion to 138% FPL and Basic Health Plan (12/2013)— 635,000
- Public Program Enrollment November 2014 847,000
- QHP Enrollment on 11/11/14 55,900
