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PDM Basics

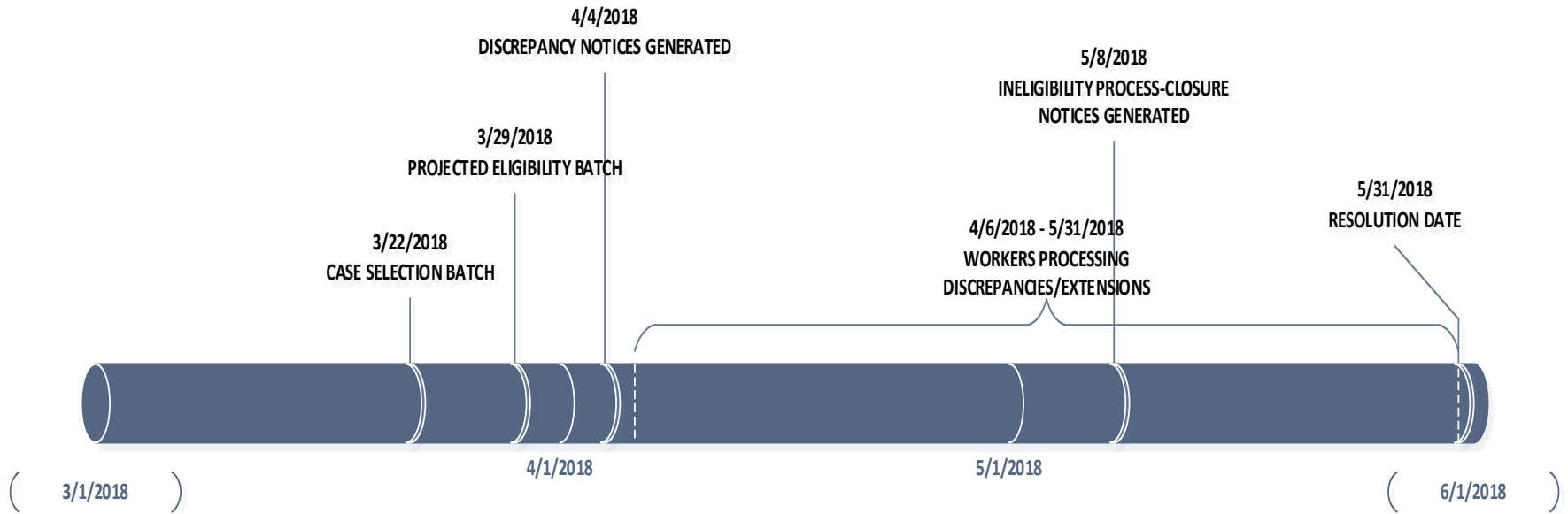
- Result of state legislation passed in 2015
- Requires DHS to conduct Periodic Data Matching (PDM) where electronic data from Data Hub is used to “project” eligibility
- Purpose is to identify public program enrollees in who may have a change in their current program

PDM Basics Cont.

- An Integrated Case undergoes PDM once per 12 month Certification Period and it is assigned to avoid Renewal dates.
- Only Medical Assistance and MinnesotaCare Enrollees in METS will be subject to PDM.
- Existing METS cases have been assigned a PDM month. New applications will be automatically assigned a PDM month upon processing.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do enrollees have to provide verification to resolve a Discrepancy?	No- written or verbal attestation is enough to resolve a Discrepancy. However, a worker may need to update a case based on the data provided by the client-this is a CIC and separate from resolving a Discrepancy.
Will a Discrepancy be raised for a beneficial program change? What about a change in MCRE premium?	Yes, a Discrepancy will be raised when the PE program is beneficial. No, a Discrepancy will not be raised if the PE would result in an increase in MinnesotaCare premiums.
Does the PDM process re-determine eligibility on a case?	No-The PDM process itself, including the projected eligibility run, does not affect eligibility on a case.
If an enrollee receives a discrepancy notice, who should I refer them to?	Refer the enrollee to the agency listed in the return address on the discrepancy notice.
