Consumer Education – helping people determine and mitigate the total cost of health care by understanding how to evaluate and compare various insurance plans/programs
The Affordability Cliff – ideas for MNsure policy/practices to ease the transition between public programs and private coverage for consumers
Individual Market Stabilization – What policy solutions can MNsure advocate for at the State level that would support individual market stabilization and increase affordability (e.g., PERA self-insured model, MinnesotaCare buy-in option for all)?
