Goal of the Consumer Assistance Program

The goal of MNsure's Consumer Assistance Program is to ensure all Minnesotans are connected to affordable and comprehensive health insurance coverage.

Purpose of Navigator Outreach and Enrollment Grants

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Navigator Outreach and Enrollment Grant Program supports this goal by funding targeted outreach to uninsured populations and sustaining a robust statewide navigator network to provide application, enrollment and renewal assistance to Minnesotans who need help to get and maintain coverage.

Funding Areas

MNsure is awarding approximately \$4.2 million in two funding areas for FY 2020 after evaluating FY 2019 Geographic and Population focus grantee performance and negotiating contract extensions with 24 grantees.

Geographic Focus (\$2.9 million)

Grants focus on building statewide access to enrollment assistance and sustaining a network of navigator organizations working closely with MNsure on strategies to reach, enroll and renew consumers.

Population Focus (\$1.3 million)

Grants support organizations that have identified populations that face barriers to enrolling in coverage and/or high levels of uninsurance and can demonstrate an ability to effectively reach, enroll and help renew coverage for the population.
