



Cost-Sharing Limits for Chronic Diseases

A new law in Minnesota limits the amount you pay for medications and supplies.

Chronic diseases covered

- Diabetes
- Asthma
- Allergies that need an epi-pen



For prescription drugs

The most you would have to pay is \$25 for a one-month supply.

This applies to each prescription drug to treat your chronic disease, if you have more than one.

For medical supplies

The most you would have to pay is \$50 per month (total).

This applies to the medical supplies related to your chronic disease medications.

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Important note: You may need to meet your health plan's deductible first.
